



# PARLIAMENT WHISKEY AND POITÍN LIST.

## DISTILLERIES 3

During the 18th/19th Century, Ireland was covered by legal and illegal distilleries, using either Pot Stills or Column/Coffey Stills. According to whiskey historians, there would have been around a thousand on the island. The majority of which ceased to exist after the early 20th century, due mainly to Ireland's newly acquired independence from England (1922) and loss of its trade routes. Some Irish politicians wanted to keep everything produced in Ireland for the Irish people, leading to American bootleggers during prohibition (1920-1933) adding "Irish" onto a bottle of whiskey as at the time, Irish whiskey was seen as the best in the world. With these bottles of homemade poison, people started to move away from Irish whiskey, and would you believe the legendary Irish Coffee (1943) put the final nail in the coffin, making people believe that the only way you could drink Irish whiskey is to mix the liquid with strong, bitter coffee, and cream.

## BLENDED/VATTED 8

For a long time blended or vatted whiskey was the main style of whiskey consumed around the world. In modern times the blended or vatted style of whiskey/whisky has been neglected, as consumers believed Single Malt and Pot Still to be far superior. The design of these whiskies is what makes them so intriguing. A master blender uses his or her years of experience to bring together liquid from a single distillery or from multiple sources to create a balanced spirit that suits palates the world over. Some of the biggest and greatest brands in the world are blended whiskies and they deserve the same respect as Single Malt, Pot Still and Single Cask whiskies.

## BOTTLERS 9

Independent bottlings have been around for over a century. This style of whiskey was created as a means for distilleries to create some extra revenue, in fact some distilleries exist solely to sell to blenders and bottlers. Distilleries sometimes sell casks that seem uncharacteristic of the distillery profile and as such cannot be used in "official" product bottlings, yet still offer high quality whiskey. Distilleries can be guessed at as these bottles generally have some hidden images or logos that hint at the distillery of origin.

These ultra rare Irish whiskeys are available for you to enjoy at cost price. With liquid from lost distilleries to very limited casks – once they're gone, that's it! Something for the real whiskey lovers.

## RARE & VINTAGE 9

Here we have a selection of some of the rarest & oldest Irish Whiskeys available. A very interesting range of blends, pot still & malts which are a wonderful reflection on the periods they came from. Some well known labels here, as well as some that no longer operate.

## POITÍN, POTCHEEN, POTEEN 10

Over the years poitín has had more downs than ups during its life. Poitín has been around long before whiskey, it is believed to have been first produced around the 6th century when monks left the monasteries on the island to spread the word of God. On their travels, they learned many new skills, one being distillation. Some people were trying to use this method to turn cheap metal into gold, others were trying to make 'Elixirs of Life', beer and wine being the most popular.

Back home they used these new methods to distill grain into poitín. This new liquid helped people survive the cold winters and was loved for its taste. When England discovered this new liquid they tried to claim it for themselves. From Poitín, whiskey sprang, and was shipped to English Parliament - where the term Parliament Whiskey comes from. Taxes were put on the liquid but the locals still produced the spirit illegally, and finally in 1661 it was outlawed. It wasn't until 1987 when Oliver Dillon circumvented tax laws by producing Bunratty Poitín for Export. In doing this he annoyed the Irish Government, who couldn't collect their dues. Finally in 1997 it was made legal to produce.

#### TULLAMORE D.E.W. DISTILLERY

The original Tullamore Distillery was opened in 1829 by Daniel E. Williams but unfortunately ceased operations in the 1950s. A new distillery was built not too far from the original in 2014.

Famous for their triple distilled, triple blended whiskey & some interesting cask finishes.

**POITÍN, POTCHEEN, POTEEN**

Poitín – a term stemming from the Gaelic word ‘Pota’ which refers to the small copper pot still used by distillers today – is a long-established distilled Irish beverage traditionally brewed from cereals, molasses, sugar beet and/or potatoes.

Despite there being no official date recorded as to when it was first produced, Poitín has a long and infamous history – indeed, it was illegal all the way up to 1997 due to excise restrictions, and it packs quite a punch at 40%-90% ABV.
