SPARKLING

DURANTE, PROSECCO DOC LA SPINEE, VENETO, 2019

BOTTLE: £25 GLASS: £6

Lightly sparkling with notes of apple and citrus on the nose and ripe stone fruit on the palate with a round finish

YVES, DUPORT ORIGINAL, BUGEY, 2018

BOTTLE: £38

From Bugey, this Methode Traditionnelle is a blend of Chardonnay, Aligote and Pinot Noir grapes. Zingy and elegant with lemon zest notes on the palate and a broad mouth feel in the finish

SEXTANT, ECUME, VIN DE FRANCE, 2018

BOTTLE: £56

A Petillant Naturel from Burgundy, made from a direct press of grapes from Beaujolais. A fun sparkling with a great tension and a combination of freshness and maturity

WHITE

MOULIN CAMUS, MUSCADET, LOIRE, 2017

BOTTLE: £25 GLASS: £6

This wild unfiltered Muscadet spends 14 months on lees and is crisp with notes of green apple and a leesy richness

SEAILLES, PRESTO, SOUTH WEST, 2019

BOTTLE: £28

A 50/50 combo of Sauvignon Blanc and Sauvignon Gris grapes with aromatic, clean-cut, grass and citrus fruit notes

YVES DUPORT, LES COTES, BUGEY, 2018

BOTTLE: £31

A clean Chardonnay from the Bugey region in between the northern Rhone and Savoie. Vinified in tanks and on lees for nearly a year, it has a round and buttery texture with notes of stone fruit

ORANGE

MAS THEO, MOGUL, VDF, RHONE, 2016

BOTTLE: £30 GLASS: £6

Located in the Northern limits of the southern Rhone near Montelimar, Mas Theo farm the native grapes with biodynamic practices which give their wines a lift and freshness not often found in this region. 40% Marsanne, 40% Roussane, and 20% Viognier grapes with notes of apricot and medicinal herbs with a waxy finish

RED

MOULIN CAMUS, MERLOT, LOIRE, 2019

BOTTLE: £25 GLASS: £6

South facing vineyards in the heart of Muscadet in the Loire Valley ensure maximum ripeness, unfiltered with earthy, gentle notes of dark fruit

MAS THEO, PETIT GABY, RHONE, 2018

BOTTLE: £29

A blend of 40% Grenache, 40% Syrah and 20% Carignan grapes with aromatic notes of red plums and savoury leather

DE LA SELVE, BEAULIEU, ARDECHE, 2016

BOTTLE: £39

A robust blend from the Ardeche in the Rhône Valley vinified in amphora. A smooth and rich juice with notes of cooked plums, fennel and cloves with a rich velvety finish

ROSÉ

CHATEAU FONTVERT, ROUCAS, PROVENCE, 2019

BOTTLE: £25 GLASS: £6

A Provence style Rosé made in Lourmarin in Luberon, this is a light pale orange colour with notes of bright red fruits on the nose and a refreshing, zingy palate with a textured finish of wild strawberries

CLOS DES GRILLONS, UNE ILE, RHONE, 2019

BOTTLE: £48

Made in the South of Tavel in the Southern Rhone, this is a blend of a Mourvedre and Picpoul grapes. Easy drinking yet complex with some spicy notes and a heady finish
